The Hon'ble Minister Finance and Human Resource Management has made the following announcement on 18.03.2022 on the floor of the assembly budget during the year 2022-2023.

கிழக்குக் கடற்கரை சாலையில் அதிகரித்து வரும் போக்குவரத்து நெரிசலைக் குறைத்திட, அக்கரை வரை நான்குவழிச் சாலையை ஆறுவழிச் சாலையாக அகலப்படுத்துவது அவசியமாகும். திருவான்மியூர், கொட்டிவாக்கம், பாலவாக்கம் பகுதிகளில் இச்சாலையை அகலப்படுத்துவதற்கு ஏற்கெனவே அனுமதி அளிக்கப்பட்டுள்ளது. நீலாங்கரை, ஈஞ்சம்பாக்கம், சோழிங்கநல்லூரில் உள்ள மீதமுள்ள சாலைப் பகுதி 135 கோடி ரூபாய் செலவில் ஆறுவழிச்சாலையாக அகலப்படுத்தப்படும். மாமல்லபுரத்திற்கு அப்பால் உள்ள கிழக்குக் கடற்கரை சாலையை தேசிய நெடுஞ்சாலைகள் ஆணையத்திடம் ஒப்படைப்பது தொடர்பான சிக்கல் தீர்க்கப்பட்டு, நான்குவழிச் சாலையாக அகலப்படுத்தும் பணிகள் விரைவில் தொடங்கப்படும்.

2. Based on the Announcement, the Chief Engineer (H) (FAC), Metro has sent the Administrative Sanction proposal for the remaining stretch from Km 15/700 – 22/300 i.e., the work of “Widening the East Coast Road (ECR) to six lane from Km 15/700 - 22/300 at Neelangarai, Injambakkam and Sholinganallur villages” at a cost of Rs.139.17 crore.

3. The Chief Engineer (H) (FAC), Metro has further stated that with respect to Land Acquisition, the Award has been pronounced and disbursement of compensation is in progress in Neelangarai-I, Injambakkam-I to IV & Sholinganallur-I villages. For Neelangarai-II & Injambakkam-V, Gramanatham portions, private negotiation proposal is under process.

4. The Chief Engineer (H) (FAC), Metro has therefore requested the Government to accord Administrative Sanction for a sum of Rs.139.17 Crore for the work of "Widening the East Coast Road (ECR) to six lane from Km 15/700 - 22/300 at Neelangarai, Injambakkam and Sholinganallur villages".

5. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of the Chief Engineer (H), (FAC), Metro and hereby accord Administrative Sanction at a restricted cost of Rs.126,94,70,477/- (Rupees One hundred Twenty Six Crore Ninety Four lakh Seventy thousand Four hundred and Seventy Seven only) (as annexed in this G.O.) and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.6,00,00,000/- (Rupees Six Crore only) for the financial year 2022-23 and the balance amount will be provided in the subsequent financial years for the work of "Widening the East Coast Road (ECR) to six lane from Km 15/700 - 22/300 at Neelangarai, Injambakkam and Sholinganallur villages".

6. The expenditure sanctioned at para-5 above, shall be debited under the following head of account:-

"5054-Capital Outlay on Roads and Bridges – 80 General – 800 Other Expenditure - State's Expenditure – JW – Chennai Metropolitan Development plan – Traffic and Transport Improvement in Chennai City - 416 Major Works – 01 Major Works."

7. The expenditure sanctioned in Para-5 above is an item of "New Instrument of Service". The approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawl of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Chief Engineer(H), Metro(FAC), is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next Supplementary Estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance(B.G-1) Department directly in Form 'A' appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (B.G-1) Department. He is also directed to send a draft explanatory notes for including the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2022-23 to Finance (B.G-1/PW-1) Department without fail.

8. The Chief Engineer (H), (FAC), Metro is authorized to incur the expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above.
