ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, orders were issued constituting a committee consisting of representatives of Finance Department, Highways and Minor Ports Department, Director General and concerned Chief Engineers' of Highways Department for scrutiny and review of the Revised Administrative Sanction proposals.

2) In the Government Order second read above, orders were issued according Administrative Sanction for an amount of Rs.500.00 Lakhs (80% amount Nabard Loan Assistance and 20% Government of Tamil Nadu Contribution) for the work of “Construction of High Level Bridge at Km 1/10 of Myladumparai – Thangammalpuram road (via) Moolakadai, Vaikalparai”.

3) The Committee on Revised Administrative Sanction in its meeting held on 03.10.2020 has approved the following proposal of Chief Engineer (NABARD and Rural Roads), Highways Department.

4) The Chief Engineer (NABARD and Rural Roads), Highways Department in her letter third read above has requested orders of the Government to accord Revised Administrative Sanction for the work of "Construction of High Level Bridge at Km 1/10 of Myladumparai – Thangammalpuram road (via) Moolakadai, Vaikalparai" for an amount of Rs.5,87,44,727/- as recommended by Revised Administrative Sanction Committee.

5) The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of the Chief Engineer (NABARD and Rural Roads), Highways Department as recommended by Revised Administrative Sanction Committee and accord Revised Administrative Sanction for the work of "Construction of High Level Bridge at Km 1/10 of Myladumparai – Thangammalpuram road (via) Moolakadai, Vaikalparai" for an amount of Rs.5,87,44,727/- (Rupees Five Crores Eighty Seven Lakhs Forty Four Thousand Seven Hundred and Twenty Seven only).

6) The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited in to the following head of account:-

7) The Chief Engineer (NABARD and Rural Roads), Highways Department is authorized to incur the expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above.

8) The expenditure sanctioned in Para 5 above shall constitute an item of "New Instrument of Service" and approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure will be initially met by an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Chief Engineer (NABARD and Rural Roads),

Highways Department is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next Supplementary Estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (B.G-I) Department directly in Form 'A' appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (B.G-I) Department. The Chief Engineer (NABARD and Rural Roads), Highways Department is also directed to send a draft explanatory notes for inclusion the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2020-2021 to Finance (B.G-I/PW-1) Department without fail.

9) This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.51570/PW-I/2021, dated.27.12.2021 and ASL No.1255 (One Thousand Two Hundred and Fifty Five).
